1	<p><i>M-15. Bricks</i></p> <p>15.1. The bricks shall be hand or machine moulded and made from suitable soils and kiln burnt. They shall be free from cracks and flaws and nodules of free lime. They shall have smooth rectangular faces with sharp corners and shall be of uniform colour.</p> <p>The bricks shall be moulded with a frog of 100mm x 40 mm. and 10mm. to 20 mm. deep on one of its flat sides. The bricks shall not break when thrown on the ground from a height of 600 mm.</p> <p>15.2. The size of modular bricks shall be 190 mm.x90 mm.x 90 mm.</p> <p>15.3. The size of the conventional bricks shall be as under : (9" x 4.3/8" x2.3/4") 225 X 110 X 75 mm.</p> <p>15.4. Only bricks of one standard size shall be used on one work. The following tolerances shall be permitted in the conventional size adopted in a particular work. Length $\pm 1/8"$(3.0 mm) Width : $\pm 1/16"$(1.50 mm.) Height : $\pm 1/16"$(1.50 mm)</p> <p>15.5. The crushing strength of the bricks shall not be less than 35 Kg/Sq. Cm. The average water absorption shall not be more than 20 percent by weight.
