# Important Instructions for Returning to Campus and Staying in the hostel

Date: 10-12-2021

### Attention to the B.Tech, M.Tech, MSc and Ph.D. Students

- 1. The students have to show their ID proof and print out of Declaration/Undertaking form duly signed by Student and their Parents/Guardian to security person at the institute main gate before entering the campus.
- 2. No students will be allowed for any undesirable movement on the campus.
- 3. Students must follow all the steps to protect themselves and others at all times, including proper use of face masks, social distancing, and hand hygiene.
- 4. Students are strictly required to follow the COVID-19 guidelines as issued/amended from time to time by Central/State/Local administration/Institute during the visit and at campus.
- 5. Any student with COVID-19 symptoms upon the arrival at the campus must report to the Institute Doctor/Hostel Supervisor immediately without fail. Such students are advised to isolate themselves till the RAPID-Antigen test is conducted.
- 6. Students returning to hostels have to follow the procedure as mentioned in the Flow Chart in Annexure-I.

#### **Instructions for Self-observation**

The existing rule of mandatory self-observation seven-day self-isolation for students arriving on campus will continue. However, as per taskforce minutes of meeting dated 24-11-202, students who report on campus during their respective physical reporting period as per the 52<sup>nd</sup> IAAC resolution No.11 and have undergone vaccination of two doses along with valid negative RT-PCR report (Within 72 hours of the arrival) at the time of arrival have to follow the below guidelines:

- 1. Report at the main gate, show the valid RTPCRT test, vaccination certificate (both dose) and go for the Rapid Antigen Test immediately. The security will help in coordination the Rapid Antigen Test. If found negative, student can go to the respective hostel and submit all the document in the respective hostel.
- 2. If student is coming in the evening/night/early morning, such student will be isolated in the Gajjar Bhavan (Boys), Mother Teresa Bhavan (Girls) and Narmad Bhavan (Family). The Rapid Antigen Test will be conducted in the Institute. If found negative, student can go to the respective hostel and submit all the document in the respective hostel.
- 3. If found positive, student will be isolated in the Narmad Bhavan (Boys/Girls/Family).
- 4. Students from the DASA Category with valid RTPCRT report, two vaccination dose are supposed to go for mandatory 7 days self-observation period at the Gajjar Bhavan (Boys) and Mother Teresa Bhavan (Girls). Students with **not fully vaccinated** and/or **not having valid RTPCR report will** go for mandatory 14 days self-observation period.

If any student other than DASA category is **not fully vaccinated** and/or **not having valid RTPCR report**, such student has to go for compulsory 7 days self-isolation as below:

1. Students are supposed to go for mandatory 7 days self observation period in the following hostels:

Gajjar Bhavan (Boys), Mother Teresa Bhavan (Girls), Narmad Bhavan (Family)

- 2. They have to bring their own Bed sheet, Pillow, Blanket and Lock-Key for door.
- 3. During 7-days self observation period, the arrangement will be made for Packed meals, breakfast, tea/coffee in their respective rooms, on payment basis (food, transportation, and packaging charge)/Mess advance.
- 4. During 7-days self observation period, the students are not supposed to move in the hostel unnecessarily. They must maintain the social distance and not interact with any other students.
- 5. Students will self-monitor their health by themselves during self observation period. In case of any symptoms will appear, they must immediately report the same to the respective hostel supervisor and seek medical consultation with the institute CMO.
- 6. Once student enters the campus, he/she will not be allowed to go out of the campus until the institute permits.
