#### <u>Important Instructions for returning to Hostels:</u>

- 1. The candidates have to show their ID proof to security person at main gate to enter the campus.
- 2. No candidates will be allowed for any undesirable movement on the campus.
- 3. Candidates must follow all steps to protect themselves and others at all times, including proper use of face masks, social distancing, and hand hygiene.
- Candidates are strictly required to follow the COVID-19 guidelines issued by Central/State/Local administration issued from time to time during the visit and at campus.
- Any candidate with COVID symptoms upon the arrival at the campus must report to the Institute Doctor/Hostel Supervisor immediately without fail. Such students are advised to isolate themselves till the RAPID-Antigen test is conducted.

### **Arrival and Accommodation at the Campus**

- All the students are instructed to report at the Security Gate. Security will guide
  you for the <u>SWAMI VIVEKANAND BHAVAN</u> (Boys) / <u>MOTHER TERESA</u>
  <u>BHAVAN</u> (Girls) Hostel. Subsequently, in the next morning, they have to go for
  RAPID-Antigen test.
- They have to bring their own Bed sheet, Pillow, Blanket and Lock & Key for door. The decent used mattress will be given in the rooms.
- During 7-days self observation period, the arrangement will be made for Packed meals, breakfast, tea/coffee in their respective rooms, on payment basis. After isolation period of seven days, the students will be shifted into their respective allotted Hostel rooms. The food arrangement will be made in their respective messes.
- Once student enters the campus, he/she will not be allowed to leave campus.
