Accordingly all students of B.Tech, Integrated M.Sc., M.Tech and Ph.D are advised to report to the campus of the institute as per above dates/schedule for attending classes/ research activities through offline mode. The mid semester examination shall be held as per above arrangements. While reporting to the SVNIT campus, the students are required to follow COVID-19 protocol and instructions for reporting at the campus (Annexure 'A' attached) and bring the copy of following documents:

a. Proof of two doses vaccination

b. A negative RTPCR report with sample taken within 72 hours of scheduled arrival to the SVNIT campus.

On arrival of the students, RAT (Rapid Antigen Test) will be conducted at the designated place of the Institute. The Hostel Section will make necessary arrangements for the Hostel inmates considering the COVID protocol. The Academic Departments are requested to make appropriate arrangements for the semester teaching, examinations, etc. mamal 17/1/202

^{**} From February 21, 2022 onwards, the day Scholars of B. Tech. 8th Semester, M.Sc. 10th Semester, M.Tech. 4th Semester and Ph.D. (second year onwards) are allowed to access the laboratories.

Instructions for students to report at the campus

- 1. Students reporting to the campus, have to essentially bring the negative RT-PCR report with sample taken within 72 hours of scheduled arrival to the SVNIT campus. No students will be permitted to enter the campus without the valid RT-PCR report.
- 2. Students must follow all the steps to protect themselves and others at all times, including proper use of face masks, social distancing, and hand hygiene.
- 3. The students are instructed to avoid gathering in groups at the common places.
- 4. Students are strictly required to follow the COVID-19 guidelines as issued/amended from time to time by Central/State/Local administration/Institute.
- 5. Any student with COVID-19 symptoms upon the arrival at the campus must report to the Institute Doctor/ Hostel Supervisor immediately without fail. Such students are advised to isolate themselves till the Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) is conducted.
- 6. On arrival to the campus, the students have to proceed to Gajjar Bhavan (Boys), Mother Teresa Bhavan (Girls) and Raman Bhavan (Family) for self-isolation till the RAT is conducted. All the students are advised to stay in their rooms before conduction of RAT at campus. The Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) will be conducted tentatively during 10.30 AM to 11.30 AM either at the institute campus or at Umra Health Centre. Those students who report in the afternoon session will go for RAT during next day. In case of negative RAT, the students will have to go to their respective hostels. In case of positive RAT, the students will have to shift to the COVID isolation facility at the campus.
- 7. Till conduction of RAT at the campus, the arrangement will be made for Packed meals, breakfast, tea/coffee in their respective rooms, on payment basis (food, transportation, and packaging charge). Student have to bring their own Bed sheet, Pillow, Blanket and Lock & Key.
- 8. Once student enters the campus, he/she will not be allowed to go outside the campus until permission from institute hostel authorities.
