Annexure-A

Two sets of self-attested copies of the following documents are required at the time of physical reporting for admission at SVNIT, Surat

- 1 Provisional Admission Letter downloaded from JoSAA portal after payment of Partial Admission Fee/Document Verification-cum-Seat Acceptance Letter downloaded from CSAB portal
- 2 Photo ID proof issued by Central Govt./State Govt./Aadhar Card
- 3 Rank Card of JEE (Main)
- 4 Class X marks sheet / certificate as proof of date of birth
- 5 Class XII (or equivalent) board mark sheet
- 6 Admit card/Hall ticket of 12th Board examination/School Leaving Certificate/Transfer Certificate
- 7 Medical Certificate as per JoSAA format
- 8 Certificate of category (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS), if applicable, as per Government of India format, available on the JoSAA website, issued by the competent authority. In case of OBC-NCL/EWS category, the certificate must be issued on or after April 01, 2022.
 - a. Caste certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL) issued by Maharashtra State must be validated by Social Welfare department (in case of SC and OBC-NCL category) and Tribal Welfare department (in case of ST category) of Maharashtra Government. The SC/ST/OBC-NCL candidates of Maharashtra State have to produce their caste validity certificate in the format available on JoSAA website.
 - b. ST certificates from Tamil Nadu state must be issued by the concerned Revenue Divisional Officer.
- 9 Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PwD)

If the original certificates are not in Hindi/ English, duly certified Hindi/ English version/translation of such certificates will be required.
