The applicant organisation must be a legally Registered entity, preferably a Registered Firm / Registered NGOs / Registered NPO / Registered Consultant / Registered Engineer / An Architect registered with the Council of Architecture with Domain Experts in the area of work or an equivalent organisation, with at least five (05) years old firm from date of registration.
