### **IMPORTANT TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

1. The bidder should consider of the following deduction component from RA/Final bill of (I) Labour Cess @ 1.0% (ii) Income Tax @ 2.0% (iii) Electricity Charges @ 0.25% and (iv) Security Deposit as per institute norms, if applicable.
2. The contractor shall procure at his expenses all permits and licenses and pay all charges and fees for law full execution of the work.
3. The contractor shall be responsible for its employees observing all security and safety rules, regulations and instructions as may be issued by the Institute from time to time. In case, the institute suffers any losses etc. or whatsoever in nature on account of the contractor's employees not following the above said norms, the contractor shall be liable to procure goods all such losses as may be determined by the institute and institute shall have the right to recover all such losses etc. from the dues payable to the contractor.
4. The work will be executed under the direct supervision of Estate (Electrical) Section.
5. The Quantities indicated in the price bid is approximate quantity only and may vary up to certain extent as per institute norms. The rates/ prices quoted by the contractor shall be fixed, throughout the contract period.
6. The contractor shall ensure disciplined behavior to all its staff/workers. If anybody found violating the norms of discipline, the contractor shall be liable to take disciplinary action against him and in extreme cases replace the same workers with new one.
7. If any contractor found employing person or persons under the age of 18 years, during course of work at any stage, legal action shall be taken against him as stipulated in Child Labour Prohibition and Regulation Act 1986 and a penalty of Rs. 20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty thousand) shall be imposed which shall be deposited with District Collector in Child Labour Rehabilitation Cum Welfare Fund.
8. The contractor shall have to make his own arrangement for housing, transportation, supplying food grains and sanitary arrangement etc. for his labour at his own expense. The Institute may provide suitable office accommodation, if available on rental basis. However, suitable space at site may be provided to the contractor for temporary office/ stores required during the execution of the work on rental basis as per institute norms and the same should be vacated within 15 days of completion of job.
9. Not with standing that all proper precautions like drainage lines, telephone, internet, water supply etc. may have been taken by contractor at all the times during progress of the work, the contractor shall be held responsible for all damages whether the work under execution or to any other property or any persons during the progress of work and the period of maintenance.
10. The contract workers must have the knowledge of Hindi or Gujarati language.
11. The acceptance of tenders will rest with the competent authority (The Director) who does not bind himself to accept the lowest one and reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without giving any reasons thereof.
12. Declaration showing all works on hand with the contractor and the value of works that remains to be executed in each case must accompany with the tender.
13. The site visit of the contractor in every week is compulsory to observe the progress of the work.
14. Tenderers have to take visit of site of installation works before filling the tender.
15. Copies of Electrical license, labour license no., P.F no. and registration certificate under Sales Tax Act for States & Central, GST, PAN Card, TAN no. etc. must be submitted with the tender documents whichever is applicable as and when required.
16. Each page of tender must be signed by tenderer.

17. The site supervisor of the contractor must provide the daily report of the material used to the concerned Site Engineer (Electrical) which must be recorded in the consumption register and to be submitted to In-charge Electrical System thrice in a week.
18. All materials to be tested and approved at Estate (Electrical) before using it at Site.
19. The contractor must submit the work plan in form of bar chart or any other suitable format along with the technical bid for execution of the work within stipulated time frame. Penalty clause may be imposed as per tender terms if stipulated time frame is violated.
20. The successful bidder is required to submit the detailed of the proposed work and get it approved before execution from the competent authority.
21. The successful bidder must test the major electrical items at company's works. The expenditure in this regard must be borne by the bidder.
22. The test certificate of switch gear used in the work is to be submitted by successful bidder.
23. Samples of materials wherever required should be approved by the faculty In-charge Electrical System before use in the installation.
24. The contractor must take necessary insurance for their personnel deputed at the institute. The institute will not be responsible for any unforeseen incidents leading to injuries or loss of life due to negligence, irresponsible behavior, or any action thereof from the concerned personnel. The contractor holds the sole responsibility regarding such incidents.
25. The contractor has to take all safety precautions. In case of any accident during execution of work/supply leading to injuries/damages to human being/equipment, or loss of life the bidder shall be fully responsible for settling all claims and indemnify the department/institute against any claim arising out of such accident.
26. The Engineer In-Charge shall have full authority to decide that excavation for earth pits shall be carried out either manually or mechanical means (such as excavator/JCB) as per the site requirements and safety considerations and contractor shall be bound to comply with such instructions without any extra claim on this account.
27. The contractor shall perform earth resistance testing using calibrated instruments as per the requirements and the earth pit resistance shall not exceed the limit specified in IS 3043. No additional charges will be provided for the same. Non-compliance test results require rectification at the contractor's cost, with re-testing until acceptance by the Engineer-in-Charge. Test certificate should be submitted after the work completion.
28. The contractor shall also be required to execute part or all of the work within the SVNIT campus, if so, directed by the Engineer-in-Charge.
29. The quantities mentioned in the Schedule of Quantities are estimated and indicative only, provided solely for reference purposes. These quantities are subject to variation - either increase or decrease, may or may not execute based on the actual site requirements and as per the norms and instructions of the institute.
30. The contractor shall carry out the necessary connection of earth strip with distribution board/Electrical panel as directed by the Engineer In-Charge.
31. The contractor should be experienced in electrical installation works of such capacity.
32. The work is to be completed within stipulated time of 45 days on allocation of the work order.
33. The quoted product should not be under end of sales or end of support in next 05 (five) year from the date of submission.
34. The contractor shall procure at his expenses all permits and licenses and pay all charges and fees for law full execution of the work.
35. The contractor shall be responsible for its employees observing all security and safety rules, regulations and instructions as may be issued by the Institute from time to time.

36. Successful tenderer shall be responsible for all tools & plants required for work.
37. In case of any accident during maintenance work / operation leading to injuries / damages to human being / equipment's, loss of life the contractor shall be fully responsible for settling all claims and indemnify the department against any claim arising out of such accident.
38. The work will be executed under the direct supervision of Engineer In-Charge Estate & Store Section-Electrical.
39. The Quantities indicated in the BoQ are approximate quantity only and may vary up to certain extent as per institute norms. The rates/ prices quoted by the contractor shall be fixed, throughout the contract period.
40. The contractor shall ensure disciplined behavior to all its staff/workers. If anybody found violating the norms of discipline, the contractor shall be liable to take disciplinary action against him and in extreme cases replace the same workers with new one.
