1. **APPLICANT MUST FULLY SATISFY ABOUT HIS/HER ELIGIBILITY AS PRESCRIBED IN OUR WEBSITE, BEFORE APPEARING IN THE TEST.**
2. The candidates are required to bring the e-Admit Card sent to their registered E-mail ID in duplicate for verification along with at least one Officially Valid ID Proof in Original for photo identification purposes (i.e. Aadhar UID, Driving License, Passport, PAN Card, Voter ID). Please note that no candidate will be allowed to appear in the written test without the e-Admit Card and a valid photo Identity proof.
3. The candidates are required to bring all original certificates for their educational qualification and relevant experience mentioned in their application form. The candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/EWS & Person with Disabilities are required to produce an original caste certificate issued by the specified/competent authority. Failing to produce above documents, the candidates will not be permitted to appear for Written test. No photocopies of the above documents shall be entertained.
4. The e-Admit Card is valid only if the candidate's photograph and signature images are legible. To ensure this, please take colour print of this e-Admit card on a A4 Size paper.
5. Candidate is advised to report to the examination venue at least one hour before the commencement of the examination. Candidate will be permitted to occupy allotted seat 30 minutes prior to the commencement of exam. The candidate will not be permitted to leave the Examination Hall before the completion of the Examination.
6. No candidate shall be allowed to enter the examination hall 15 minutes after the commencement of the Test
7. Candidate is not allowed to carry any electronic device in the exam hall.
8. Use of programmable Calculator, Mobile, Bluetooth device, Electronics/Smart Watch etc. is strictly prohibited.
9. Use only blue/black ball point pen to darken the circle for correct/most appropriate answer in the response sheet. In no case gel/ink pen or pencil should be used in the response sheet.
10. The candidate is required to sign in the attendance sheet at the time of examination
11. Negative marking will be applicable for every incorrect attempt.
12. If a candidate is inadvertently allowed to appear at the test / Interview who otherwise doesn't fulfil the minimum eligibility requirements, the candidate can't, at a later date, use that as a right to claim that candidate meets the eligibility requirements.
13. Please note that, the admit card is valid for written examination for Paper-I (Stage-1). Those candidates who qualify in Paper-1 (Stage-1) shall be called for Skill Test (Stage-2), i.e. Typing Test on Computer to access the minimum Typing Speed of 35 w.p.m. in **English only**.
14. The candidates who qualify in Skill Test (Stage-2) shall be called for document verification and written examination for paper-II (Stage3). The written examination for paper II (Stage 3) shall be held after declaration of result of Skill Test (Stage-2).
