- ◇ 59 Kendriya Vidyalayas started in 3 years and 50 new sanctioned. Total 109

Navodaya Vidyalayas

- ◇ 62 new Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas sanctioned of which 27 will be operational from this academic year.



LEARNING OUTCOMES

शिक्षा की उपलब्धियां

- ◇ RTE Act was passed in 2009, but Learning Outcomes were not defined
- ◇ Learning Outcomes notified to benchmark competency to be achieved by students in each standard
- ◇ This will create accountability across all stakeholders teachers, parents and students



CHANGE IN NO DETENTION POLICY

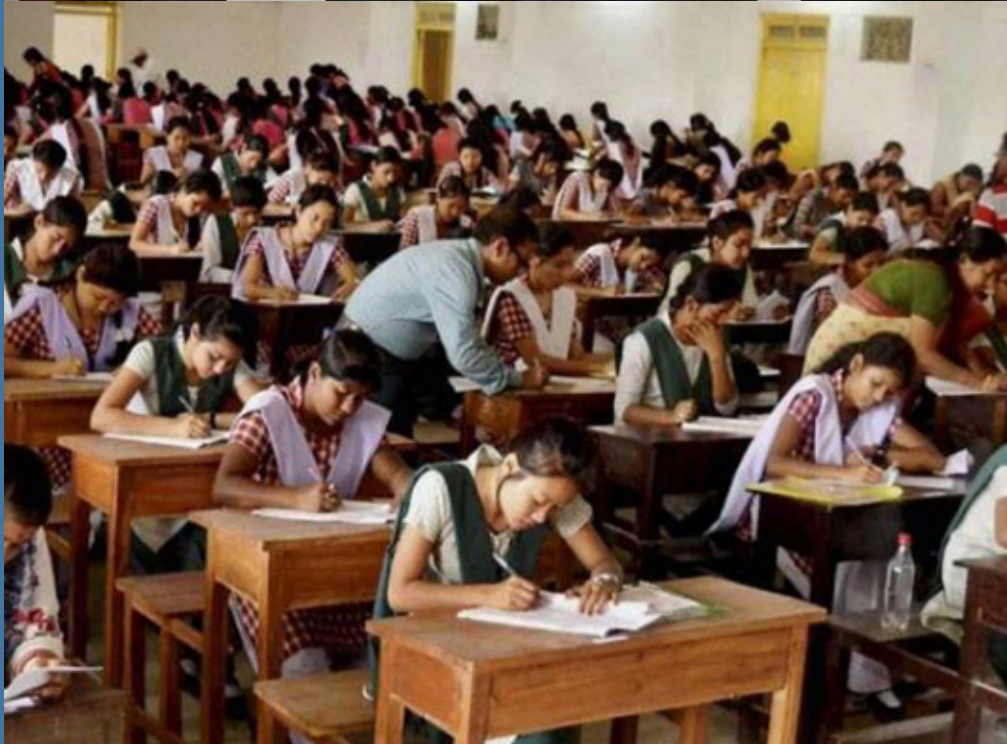
- ◇ CBE unanimously decided to give the right to States to detain or not to detain students
- ◇ States authorized to detain students in V and/or VIII standard after giving 2 chances
- ◇ The Bill in this regard is in circulation





BOARD EXAMINATION FOR CLASS X

- ◇ Earlier 50% CBSE students used to appear for board exams and the others did not
- ◇ Board exams now made mandatory
- ◇ This has been welcomed by all stakeholders
- ◇ **All State Boards and CBSE have agreed not to inflate marks in board examinations, making them realistic**





REFORMS IN TEACHER EDUCATION

- ◇ Affidavits received from more than 7,000 Teacher Education colleges
- ◇ Show-cause notice issued to those who haven't submitted affidavits
- ◇ 2017-18 to be zero year as no new B.Ed/ D.Ed colleges to be sanctioned
- ◇ Pre-service and In-service teacher education is under complete revamp
- ◇ Practical lessons would be conducted in Government schools



SHIKSHAN MANTHAN

- ◇ Five Regional Workshops of all stakeholders organized for Innovation in pedagogy, teaching, learning and improvement of quality
- ◇ Four Workshops in Raipur, Pune, Guwahati, Bengaluru already conducted and next in Chandigarh

◇ 9,567 students appeared for JEE

◇ 3,567 cracked JEE Mains

◇ 481 admitted to IITs last year





KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS

- ◇ 1,140 KVs provide quality education for masses at highly affordable cost
- ◇ Online admissions for EWS category completed
- ◇ HRD to expand KV network with innovative model





KGBV

(Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalaya)

- ◇ Upper Primary Residential Schools for Girls
- ◇ Schools for girls from SC, ST, OBC and other minority/ disadvantaged sections of society
- ◇ There are currently 3,703 KGBVs functional across India
- ◇ 94 new KGBVs sanctioned in 2017-18





STATE GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS

- ◇ Quality Initiatives by many States have succeeded in attracting students from Private Schools to Government Schools
- ◇ Shikshan Manthan will ensure more States to follow on this route
- ◇ All efforts are being taken to improve Quality of Education in Government Schools



MID-DAY MEAL SCHEME

- ◇ India has world's largest Mid-day Meal scheme, serving 10-crore students in 11.5 lakh schools with nutritious food
- ◇ Economic Cost involved per student

Rice based	Rs. 6.64	Rs. 9.6
Wheat based	Rs. 5.7	Rs. 8.2



ADULT LITERACY

- ◇ 3-crore illiterate adults have achieved basic literacy
- ◇ Functional skills have been imparted.
- **Electoral Literacy:** 100% enrolment of women and youth, resulting in enhanced voting percentage
- **Financial Literacy:** More than 10 million beneficiaries bank accounts under Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana opened
- **Legal Literacy:** Awareness created about laws, rules, procedures; rights, duties and entitlements; sex determination, domestic violence, prevention of atrocities etc.

- ◇ 6 new IITs established in Jammu, Bhilai, Dharward, Goa, Palakkad and Tirupati
- ◇ 1 new IIIT established at Kurnool (Temporary campus at Kancheepuram)

- ◇ To create world class research facilities in India
- ◇ Canara Bank is the agency and the scheme is operational

RUSA

(Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan)

- ◇ Rs. 4816 Crore sanctioned for 1366 Institutes to improve infrastructure

Central assistance provided for:

- ◇ 16 Universities through upgradation of autonomous colleges and clustering of colleges
- ◇ 60 new model degree colleges
- ◇ Upgradation of 54 colleges to model degree college
- ◇ 29 new professional colleges
- ◇ Infrastructure grant to 1250 colleges and 117 universities



TEQIP -III

- ◇ Phase III of TEQIP to improve quality of technical education launched with Rs. 2,600 crores funding from World Bank and Government of India
- ◇ Focus on most backward regions, north-east and hilly states
- ◇ J&K, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh and north eastern states, A & N Island, Odisha, Jharkhand, Bihar, Rajasthan covered



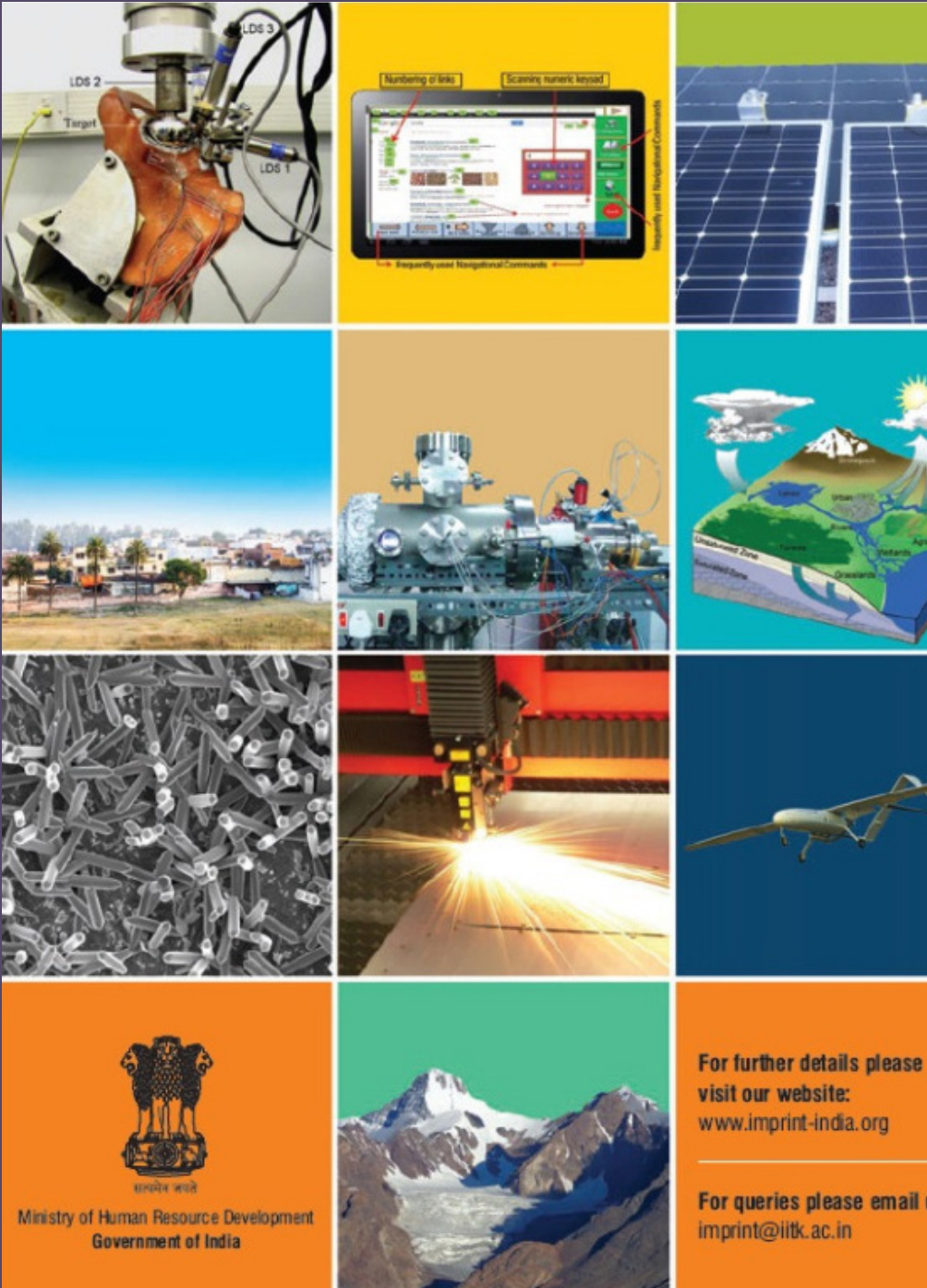
IMPRINT (Impacting Research Innovation & Technology)

- ◇ Industry funded research projects focussed on innovation
- ◇ Meaningful Industry-Institute-Academia interaction initiated for the first time
- ◇ 92 Project proposals accepted
- ◇ 300 faculty and students working on these projects will boost joint ventures of universities/institutes/industry



INCUBATION & START-UPS

- Started in IITs/NITs/IIMs/Universities for incubating start-ups
 - ◇ 6 new research parks
 - ◇ 16 Tech business incubators
 - ◇ 15 Start-up centres
- More than 600 start-ups supported till now
- IIT Madras research park is fully functional with 20 Lakh square-feet research area


- ◇ 38 Central Universities to be Wi-Fi enabled from July 2017

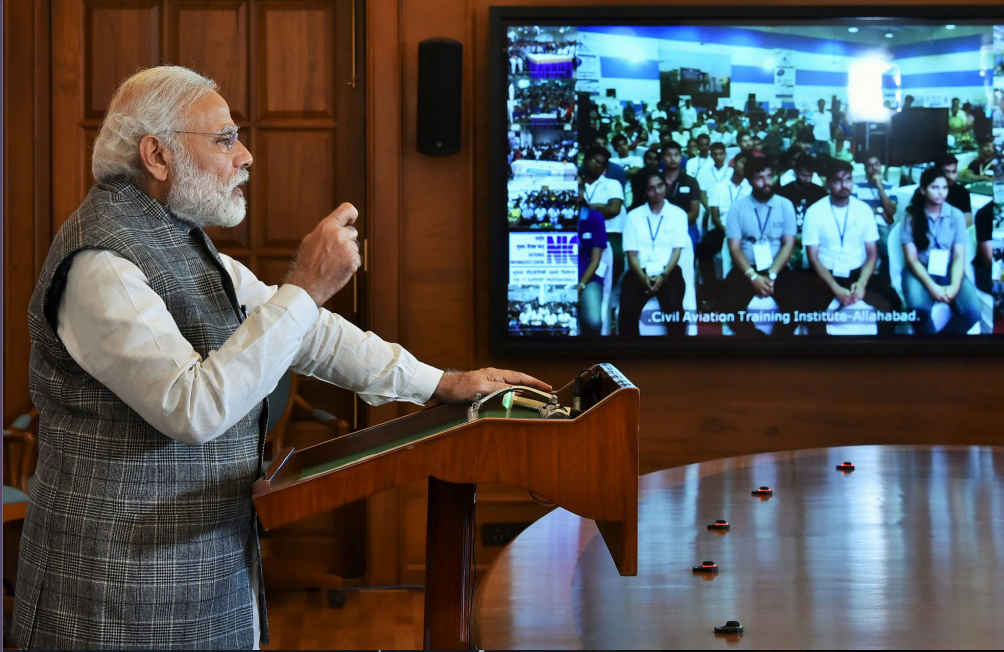

- ◇ Choice Based Credit System will give flexibility to students for selecting courses of their choice





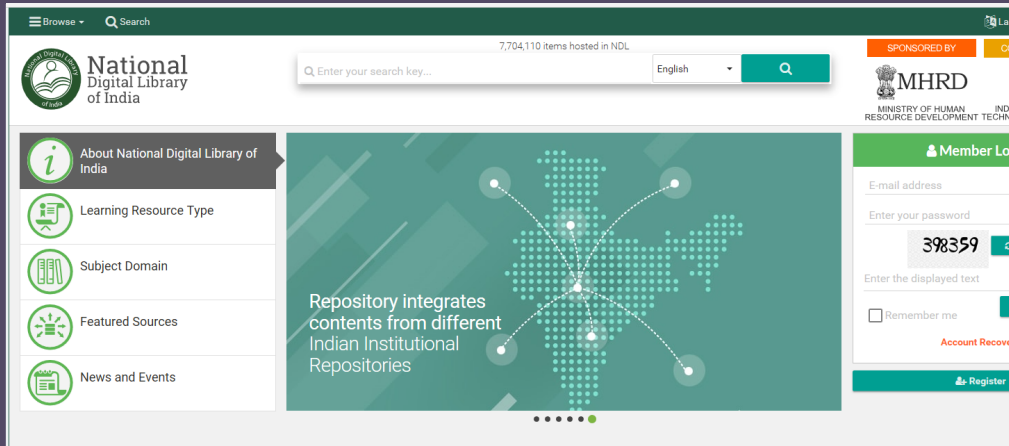
HACKATHON

- ◇ Unique opportunity for engineering students for working on projects to find digital solutions for various citizens' problems
- ◇ 30 Departments/Ministries gave 600 problem statements
- ◇ 42,000 students from over 2,000 engineering colleges participated
- ◇ Worked for 3 months on the problem statements
- ◇ On April 1 & 2, 10,000 students worked non-stop for 36 hours and submitted digital solutions for about 200 problems

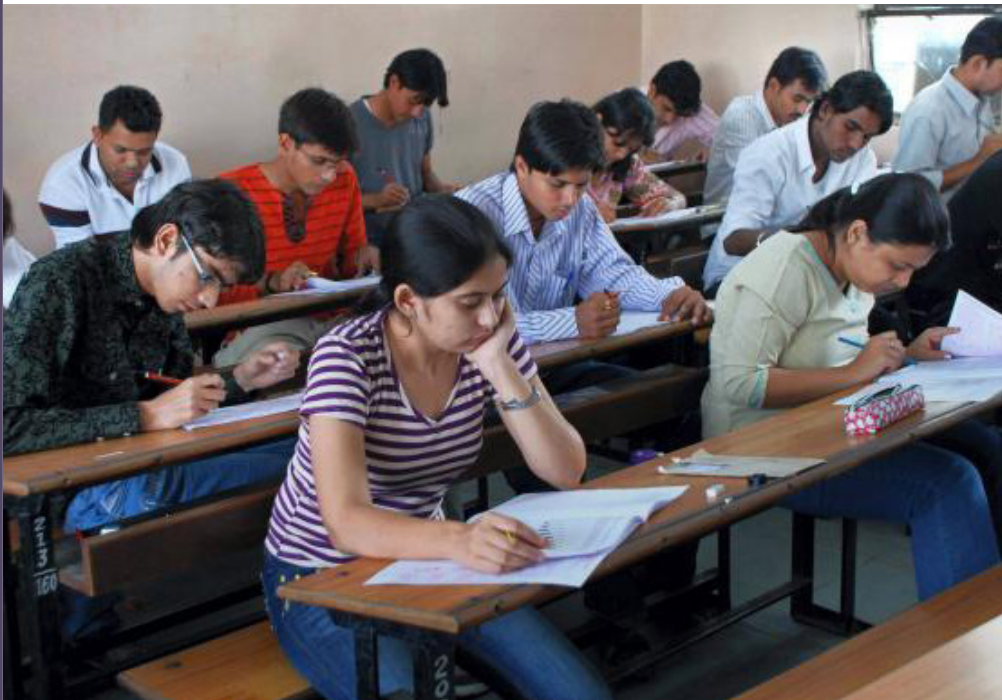


NATIONAL ACADEMIC DEPOSITORY

- ◇ To store Educational Certificates in Digital Format from this year

NATIONAL TESTING AGENCY

- ◇ An autonomous, self-sustaining premier testing organization to conduct all entrance examinations for higher education institutions
- ◇ This would free CBSE, AICTE etc. so that they can focus more on academics



REFORMING UGC/AICTE

- ◇ The process of Reforming two Regulators of Higher Education - UGC & AICTE- is in progress
- ◇ Graded autonomy to be introduced
- ◇ More freedom for Quality Institutions and regulation for Institutions with low quality
- ◇ Incentivising autonomy for Quality Institutions
- ◇ IIM Bill in Parliament to grant complete autonomy to IIMs
- ◇ Expansion of Open Learning
- ◇ ODL rules revamped and online regulations in progress to bring in transparency, ensure quality and provide students with better opportunities

Reforms in Regulations...



REFORMING NAAC, NBA, NIRF

- ◇ NAAC Accreditation and Assessment procedures have been further revised to benchmark quality of an Institute
- ◇ NIRF has been successfully conducted for the last 2 years and will be improved further
- ◇ This has ensured healthy competition among educational institutions



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Digital Literacy Campaign Vittiya Saksharta Abhiyan

- ◇ Vittiya Saksharta Abhiyan(Digital Financial Literacy Campaign) after Demonetisation is a roaring success
- ◇ 4.30 Lakh volunteers from 4892 institutions taught 20 lakh families
- ◇ 19.34 Lakh individuals were converted to using digital payments
- ◇ 1.23 lakh shops converted to using digital payments
- ◇ The campaign will continue throughout the year

- Common portal for various scholarship schemes
- Creates a transparent database of scholars
- Ensures timely disbursement of scholarships
- Facilitates Direct Benefit Transfer of scholarships

SCHOLARSHIPS

School Education

- ◇ 3.7 Lakh school students given National Means-Cum-Merit Scholarship at the rate of Rs. 500 per month
- ◇ 9.65 Lakh school girls benefitted at the rate of Rs. 3,000 per annum under National Scheme of Incentive to Girls

Higher Education

- ◇ 3,38,493 scholarships granted to meritorious students of Colleges/ Universities at Rs.10,000/ 20,000 per year in the last 3 years
- ◇ 2.1 Lakh beneficiaries under all UGC fellowship/ scholarship schemes during last 3 years
- ◇ PG scholarship by AICTE to 40,000 students per year @ Rs. 12,400 per month per student for Engineering & Pharmacy
- ◇ 4,000 girls students of colleges were given scholarship of Rs. 5,000 per annum

Central Sector Interest Subsidy Scheme (CSISS)

- ◇ Interest subsidy provided on education loans to EWS students, whose parental income is less than Rs. 4.5 lakhs
- ◇ Full interest subsidy provided by the Government during moratorium period (course period + 1 year)
- ◇ 4,39,818 students benefitted with an amount of Rs. 2,290 crores in the last three years

Special Scholarship Scheme for J&K students

- ◇ 24,200 scholarships granted
- ◇ @ Rs. 2.25 lakhs per year, per student for Engineering courses
- ◇ @ Rs. 4 lakh per year, per student for Medical courses
- ◇ @ Rs. 1.3 lakh per year per student for General courses
