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1. Introduction of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan is a flagship program of Ministry of Education for sustainable rural development and launched on 11th November, 2014.

- Vision: "Transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build the architecture of an Inclusive India".
- Mission: To enable higher educational institutions to work with the people of rural India in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for accelerating sustainable growth.
- Aim: To create a virtuous cycle between society and an inclusive academic system by providing knowledge and practices for emerging professions and to upgrade the capabilities of both the public and the private sectors in responding to the development needs of rural India.

1.1: Background & Need

- Urbanization and centralized technologies increase inequity and climate change due to rapid ecological degradation.
- To ameliorate these problems, it is necessary to promote development of rural areas in tune with the Mahatma Gandhiji's vision of self-sufficient "Village Republic" based on local resources and using decentralized, eco-friendly technologies, and education are locally met.
- Presently, around 70% of population in India lives in rural areas engaged in an agrarian economy with agriculture and allied sector employing 51% of total work-force but accounting for only 17% of total country's GDP.
- There are huge development disconnects between the rural and urban sectors such as inequity in health, education, incomes and basic amenities as well as employment opportunities-all causing great disconnect and large-scale migration to urban areas.









Unnat Bharat Abhiyan has been conceived to explore the potential of higher educational institutions to enrich rural India.












1.4: Structure of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan











1.5: UBA National Steering Committee

- An empowered Steering Committee has been constituted by the Ministry of HRD for actual implementation, continuous guidance and monitoring of the programme at the national level.
- Dr. Vijay P. Bhatkar, an eminent scientist and rural development enthusiast has been designated as the Chairperson of the National Steering Committee (NSC) with stalwarts like Dr. Mashelkar (Ex Director General, CSIR), Dr. Ved Prakash (Ex-Chairman, UGC) and Dr. Sahasrabudhe (Chairman, AICTE) and others as the members.
- The first meeting of the NSC was held at IIT Delhi on 29th April, 2016 and it was decided that the NSC will be meeting quarterly to provide direction and requisite thrust to the programme.
- The coordinators of the overall coordinating institute, the mentoring institutes and the subject expert groups will be regularly reporting to the NSC.









1.6: UBA National Coordinating Institute

- Indian Institute of Technology, IIT Delhi is a National Coordinating Institute for Unnat Bharat Abhiyan Scheme.
- The main task of the coordinating institute is to facilitate mutual interaction, consultation, responsibility allocation and an active liaison among the mentoring institutions, the subject expert groups as well as the Ministry of HRD.
- It will also closely interact with the NSC in connection with the allocation of funds and other facilitating measures for effective and smooth running as well as the nation-wide proliferation of the UBA program.
- The NCI has overall responsibility in selection, training of institutions, constituting the Subject Expert Groups and monitoring the program through a web portal.

They are accountable for successful implementation of the UBA as per the objectives of program.









1.7: UBA Regional Coordinating Institute

These institutions will act as nodal centers for promoting, guiding, monitoring & facilitate UBA network in their region.

- These will be responsible for grooming the other participating institutions in their region in addition to carrying out their own village cluster activities.
- The RCIs have a strategic role to play; they have to identify a challenge relevant in their region / states in collaboration with PIs and State government.

1.8: UBA Participating Institutes

The Participating Institute is expected to closely coordinate with the State Government/ District Administration / Panchayat Raj Institutions / other stakeholders including voluntary organizations with responsibility of sustainable development adopted Village Cluster.

2.0: SVNIT, Surat as RCI-UBA

SVNIT has a campus of its own, spread over 100 hectares of land on the Surat-Dumas Highway. Surat is a top-ranking industrial city of the country with clean wide roads and over bridges. It is well known worldwide for textiles, zari, embroidery, and diamond industries. Several large-scale industries are located in the city. Surat is situated on the main western railway route between Vadodara and Mumbai and connected to all parts of the country through rail networks. The institute is located at Ichchhanath on Surat-Dumas Road at a distance of about 10 Km from Surat railway station and airport.






Fig. 1: Number of participating institutes - District wise

Need of the Activity:As per received many complaints about joint pain, knee pain and headache problems from the many villagers of the Junagam village, PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat has decided to check the drinking water quality as available in the Junagam village.

Brief Description (Need/Impact/Action/Picture (if any)): Participating Institute – Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, SVNIT, Surat has investigated and survey the drinking water facility available in the Junagam village. As per the current practices, all the villagers bring 20-liter plastic bottles in every morning / evening for filling the drinking water from the two-community level RO water treatment plant. The RO water treatment plant filters the ground water from borewell by 40 – 50ft below the ground level.









PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat has advised to Junagam Gram Panchayat for detailed testing of source water (borewell water) and RO Outlet water (drinking water of the Junagam) in the private laboratory as available in Surat City. Then after, the sample was collected by Pollucon Laboratory, Surat for testing on 7th June, 2021.

Brief Description (Need/Impact/Action/Picture (if any)): Based on the detailed test report of community level RO treatment plant (Reported on 18th August, 2021 from Pollucon Laboratory Pvt Ltd, Bhatar, Surat) as available source of drinking water for villagers of the Junagam Village; PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat has conducted detailed discussion with the experts- 1) Dr. K. D. Yadav, SVNIT, Surat and 2) Dr. Rajkumar Satankar, IIT Jodhpur.

As per expert opinion, it has needed to increase the Total Dissolve Solids (TDS) of exiting drinking water facility as available as both the community level RO water treatment plant.

On 18th November, 2021, PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat has communicated with the Manthan Jal Pvt Ltd, Surat for visiting the existing community level RO plants and team was visited the both plant and analyse the situation. After primary visit, the team has decided to fit and install digital TDS controller device in both the RO treatment plant.

On 30th November, 2021, the team has successfully installed the digital TDS controller in both the RO treatment plant.

















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Activity 3.1.21: Site visit and discussion regarding solid waste management of the Bhatalai Village on 1st December, 2021

Need of the Activity: To review the current situation of solid waste management and discussion on appropriate solutions regarding environment friendly solid waste management

Brief Description (Need/Impact/Action/Picture (if any)): PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat has visited the current solid waste disposal site along with officers from ECO vision Pvt Ltd, Suratand United Nations Education, Science and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO)

The team has reviewed the current practice of dealing with daily collection of waste and its management with village officials and also long discussion with waste collector driver.

The team was collected the information as required and it was decided to start with plastic waste collection and recycling in existing plastic waste treatment plant as available with the ECO vision Pvt Ltd in the Bhatar, Surat. Regular weekly collection vehicle will come for collection of accumulated and segregated plastic waste from the village.

And in the next phase, other than plastic waste, all kind of dry waste will be sold to the recyclers and compost / vermicompost will be created from daily generated biodegradable wet waste in the village by providing training to the villages to make a self-sufficient auto run model.













Activity 3.1.22: Performing the drinking water test analysis of the Junagam village after installation of digital TDS controller

Need of the Activity: To review the implemented intervention in both community level drinking water RO plants

Brief Description (Need/Impact/Action/Picture (if any)): PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat has taken the samples of available drinking water samples from both of community level RO water treatment plant of the Junagam Village and tested major important parameters in the Environment Engineering laboratory, SVNIT, Surat.

The purpose of testing is to make surety about successful working the implemented digital TDS controller. The sample was collected on 8th December, 2021 and test analysis result made after laboratory testing on 10th December, 2021 as shown in below table.

Brief Description (Need/Impact/Action/Picture (if any)): PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat has collected the banana fibre pulp from banana processing unit and performed experiment of making the organic banana fibre sanitary pads from existing innovative sanitary pad making machine at Bhatalai Village. Though the sanitary pads have made but the quality has not achieved as per requirement.

Whatsapp groups for Papad, Roti, Aata, Chakari, Khaman-Dhokala, Sev, Wafer etc. food making and processing machines. This will help to women SHGs for enhancing their production.







Activity 3.1.25: Quality checking of the existing banana fiber sanitary pad producing by using sanitary pad making unit in Bhatalai Village as per IS 5405-2019

Need of the Activity: To validate the exiting banana fiber sanitary pad and analysis of quality for mass selling in the market.

Brief Description (Need/Impact/Action/Picture (if any)): PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat has developed the banana fiber sanitary pad manufacturing machinery and organic banana fiber sanitary pad. Now, the time of quality checking and product validation has come.

PI-UBA SVNIT, Surat helped to Krishna SHG, Bhatlai Village for finding the BIS approved laboratory Envirocare Pvt Ltd, Thane, Maharashtra and send the 25 nos. of banana fiber sanitary pad to the laboratory on 14th February 2022, the Krishna SHG has sent the first sample to the BIS approved lab – Envirocare Pvt Ltd, Thane, Maharashtra and the result received has found not okay as per standards. **(Report – I)**






