Accommodation are preferred in the tents at nearby camping grounds and In addition of these activities, sky observation & direction finding are also undertaken for basic information of the participants. So moreover, this camping includes adventure activities, site seeing & adventurous stay at Saputara and nearby places.

About Saputara

Saputara is situated in the heart of Dang district. Perched on the second highest plateau of the Sahyadri range, it literally means the 'abode of serpents'.

Overlooking a lush green valley, this unpretentious destination is a good place to unwind, go trekking or take leisurely hill walks.

Blessed with exhilarating natural beauty, the town has verdant forests, gorgeous waterfalls and a plethora of lush gardens & lake.



Sunrise Point

Sunrise Point is a famous vantage point & magnificent places located in Saputara, Gujarat.

Also known as Valley View point.

Known for the splendid view of sunrise, Sunrise Point is a very serene and calm place to start your day with.

Situated on the crest of a hill, this viewpoint gives a breath-taking view of the sunrise among the hills of Western Ghats.

During monsoons, one can also see a number of waterfalls in the surrounding areas and dense green foliage.



Gira Waterfall

Gira (Giradudh) waterfalls is Gujarat's most popular & Largest natural waterfalls located near Saputara hill station. Also known as Giradudh, Gira Waterfall is formed over the Kapri River and eventually drops into the Ambika River.

Breathtakingly beautiful around monsoon, these seasonal (only after rains) falls are among the most picturesque sights.

The 30 m natural drop in the river Ambika, river makes for an amazing videography or photography.
