From the President's Desk

Er. Dushyant Mehta Mechanical – 1988 SVNIT AA – President

Dear Friends and Colleagues,

I Welcome You All at the SVNIT ALUMNI REUNION 2019.

It has been my great pleasure and privilege to serve our SVNIT ALUMNI ASSOCIATION since last six years, earlier in my capacity as Comm. Member and Vice President too. The Elections for Mg. Committee of our SVNIT Alumni Association are held very transparently every two years by Election Commissioners with full scrutiny of the nominations filed. The nominations are filed by those Alumni who are willing to serve honorarily and also willing to dedicate their time and money for the job, without any remuneration of any kind whatsoever.

Our Past Alumni Members have done a great job by registering our SVNIT Alumni Association as a Registered Co-operative Society with the Registrar of Co-operative Societies Surat; under the Gujarat State Co-op Societies Act. Simultaneously, they have also got our Association registered as a Public Trust; under The Bombay Public Trusts Act 1950. Thereby we all Committee members are shouldering a double responsibility, not only as Mg. Committee of the society, but also as Trustees of the Trust. Both these responsibilities being inseperable, makes us absolutely dedicated in the service and for the welfare of the SVNIT Students and Alumni as a whole. This makes our SVNIT Alumni Association an autonomous body with the Hnble Director as an ex-officio Chairman of our Association with the Director/ Dean – Alumni Affairs as a mandatory signatory in the operation of the bank account of the Association alongwith two Office bearers of the Association.

For the First time, The current Mg. Comm. has filed Audited Accounts with Audit Report with both the govt. bodies ie the Registrar of Co-op Societies, Surat and with the Charity Commissioner, Surat and also filed IT return. We have now applied for IT exemption 80-G Certificate with the Govt. authorities, so that all Alumni can donate money to the Association and claim IT exemptions.

In April 2018, our Hnble Director, Dr. Gandhi decided to amend the existing `Memorandum of Association~` of our SVNIT Alumni Association and selected a team of 8 highly learned persons, consisting of 2 very senior Alumni, 2 from the newly elected Committee, 2 Past Dean Alumni and 2 from faculty, such MOA Reconstruction Committee headed by himself. After several meetings and discussions, in May 2019, the new MOA was unanimously passed by the Mg. Comm. Therafter in August 2019, the same was unanimously adopted and passed in the special GBM by the Alumni and

we adopted the new MOA for SVNIT Alumni Association.

In April 2018, Our Association has donated Rs. 10 Lakhs to the Institute to provide facility of Volley Ball Court and Cricket pitch for the students of SVNIT. However due to unforeseen administrative delays by the Institute, the work has just started now and will be completed soon.

Now Our Association has also started providing financial aids in various forms to financially challenged students as needed by them, including giving financial aid to attend conference and seminars in India and abroad where their papers are being published.

In September 2019, students of our SVNIT held All India NIT Conference titled THINK INDIA held for the first time in Surat, (assisted by Prof. Pradhan and Prof. Bhatt), when our Association was approached by the students, we immediately agreed and sponsored the All India NIT Conference held here. It is our endeavour to lift the ranking of our SVNIT in the first 10 premium institutes amongst the 23 IITs and 31 NITs of our country. It is a Difficult task, but with our collective efforts, we will ACHIEVE it. That's what we were taught, that's what we have learnt. The working prototypes displayed like Drone, Exoskeleton, Racing cars hydraulic, pneumatic & electrical fault detection system, etc were highly appreciated by visiting ISRO scientist, DRDO Chairman and various other visiting dignitaries.

We have introduced `Ace Alumnus Awards` to appreciate and honour our various Alumni (on our own platform,) who have done/doing exemplary work in their professional and social field and achieving great heights not only for themselves but also for our Alma Mater, SVRCET/SVNIT. The same is headed by Er. Nilesh Shah of 1987 Civil.

We have launched various programmes for the Students so as to make them ready for the future in the highly competitive world, the Prime being launching the Accelerator Program to be headed by Er. Harsh Thakker of 1970 batch, based in USA, but also a frequent visitor and having his second home in Surat; assisted by Dr. Abdul Shaikh from the faculty. Students who come up with innovations need to give an elevator speech (short speech) and pitch their idea and present how they will commercialise their innovation. This can be backed by market surveys, payback period, CAPEX, OPEX, etc...Those students or group who can pitch satisfactorily may be given a basic funding (an accelerator) or will get tied up with a manufacturer to bring their innovation / prototype on a manufacturable scale. We have also roped in Dr. Anish Gandhi, Principal of C K Pithawala college of Engineering, who is our Alumnus and a Professional Consultant for Patent and Design registration who will assist these students and faculty alongwith the Program head for securing IPR. Noteworthy to state that all are providing their services in a selfless and honorary manner as a payback to their Alma Mater.

The main idea to launch this program is to make our students, the future technocrats of our country, industry ready and to gear them to begin their own small scale startups in under MSMEs with a larger emphasis in the manufacturing sector rather than service sector and generate large employment of skilled and semi-skilled workers by taking full advantage of the Skill India and Make In India schemes launched successfully by Govt of India. A proper guidance to these budding technocrats by senior Alumni and Businessmen can boost the small scale manufacturing sector in our country.

We have also launched the `SVNIT Engg Expo` to display various innovations and prototypes made by our students and Alumni and also allowed participation of industries so that we can boost the professional career of the students and alumni. The participation is free for our students and discounted for our Alumni. Our very senior and three past Presidents , Er. Bhadresh Shah, Er. Bharat Patel and Er. Suresh Malik are primararily overlooking this project which is the brain child of Er. Bhadresh Shah. The Expo is open to all for participation and visiting.

We also plan to create a Medical Corpus for the financially challenged Alumni and their family so that interest earned on such corpus can be used to provide medical assistance to them and their immediate family members. This will be our small effort to provide social security for our financially challenged brethren.

Our main idea in holding Alumni Reunion every year is to engage interaction between various Alumni of all age groups and all fields alongwith the students and to help each other in the professional field and career. Keeping this in mind, we have allowed free registration and participation of all undergraduate students of SVNIT in such reunions.

We also expect and request highly designated Alumni to instruct their companies/organistions to provide internships to our students as well as send their HRD for interviews and placements at our Campus during the hiring season.

We expect the senior Alumni above the age of 62 yrs to engage themselves in advisory and guiding role for the students and the Mg. Committee rather than in the executive role as members in Mg. Comm. so that new ideas can proliferate and can be carried forward under their guidance.

Friends, the list is endless, but we have started and we have to accelerate it, now collectively. We take this opportunity and urge our Alumni friends to come forward and donate in cash or kind to the Association which will be carried forward exactly as per their wish and instructions for the benefit of students and Alumni as a whole.

I am thankful to all Dr. S R Gandhi, Dr. P L Patel, Dr. J N Patel, Er. P. Timbadia, Dr. K D Yadav, Er. Bharat Patel, Er. Nilesh, Er. Akshay and my Mg. Committee teammates, Er. Ketan Er. Ravi, Er. Viral, Er. Tushar, Er. Parasji, Er, Piyush, Er. Ranjitji, Er. Minesh, Er.Anilji, for their continued support and guidance.

On the accounts of Bombay Public Trusts Act 1950 and the Gujarat State Co-op Societies Act, Audited Accounts have been filed with Audit Report with both the govt. bodies i.e. the Registrar of Co-op Societies, Surat and with the Charity Commissioner, Surat and the IT return has also been filed by the current Mg. comm. We have now applied for IT exemption 80-G Certificate with the CBDT so that the money can be donated by alumni to the Association and IT exemptions can be claimed.

In order to amend the existing Memorandum of Association~` of our SVNIT Alumni Association, our hon. Director Dr. Gandhi headed MOA Reconstruction Committee of 8 highly qualified individuals, which consisted of 2 very senior Alumni, 2 from the newly elected Committee, 2 former presidents and 2 from the faculty. After many hours of discussions, the committee suggested some changes in MOA. In June 2018, the changes were adapted in Mg. Comm. Meeting. Thereafter in August 2019, the same was unanimously adopted and passed in the AGM by the General Body. Hence the new MOA was adopted and started operations as the new MOA for SVNIT Alumni Association.

In September 2019, The first All India NIT Conference titled THINK INDIA was held by SVNIT students in Surat. When the students approached our association, without any hesitance we agreed to sponsor the event.

In order to encourage and honour our various Alumni (on our own platform) who have done or have been doing some impeccable work in their respective professional and social field and have allotted a great respect not only for themselves but also for our Alma Mater, 'Ace Alumnus Awards' has been introduced by us.

Civil Engineering Department

The Civil Engineering Department is one of the founding departments of the Institute. The vision of the department is to become a global centre of excellence for creating competent civil engineering professionals. The department has grown tremendously over the years, especially after the conversion of the institute to an NIT, and is now one of the best Civil Engineering Departments among NITs in the country. At present the department has 25 permanent full-time faculty members and more are expected to join soon. The faculty are well trained in the best institutes of the country, and provide high quality teaching and research. The B.Tech. programme of the department is run along with the Department of Applied Mechanics Department which has 13 faculty members.

The activities of the department are carried out under four different sections namely, Environmental Engineering, Transportation Planning & Engineering, Urban Planning and Water Resources Engineering, and the department runs four M. Tech. programmes in these specializations. The department has all the essential laboratory facilities to carry out basic research in these areas.

In addition to the regular academic activities, the department also undertakes outreach activities for teachers of the colleges and professionals in industries. Regular short-terms programmes are arranged in different specialized areas to suit the requirements of the professionals. Research activities undertaken by the faculty and students of the department supported by various governmental agencies primarily focus on applied research. The department also helps the industries/agencies to find solution to their problems. The Centre of Excellence on Water resources and Flood Management under the department aims to develop state-of-the-art computational and experimental facilities for solving the related issues. A recently formed Centre for Clean Environment Research hopes to work in unison with the industry to find solutions to the environmental/pollution related problems with a focus on Surat city.



The Department of Computer Engineering originated from the Department of Electronics Engineering, and has a vibrant history of around 30 years. The undergraduate degree in Computer Engineering at S V National Institute of Technology, has been offered since 1988-89, with the first batch of Bachelors of Computer Engineering graduating in 1992 (intake 30) under the patronage of the erstwhile Department of Electronics Engineering. The Department of Computer Engineering was bifurcated from the Department of Electronics Engineering in

2002. With a focus on balancing high-quality research to substantiate the class-room teaching the PhD program has been started in the year 2005 and the inception of the M Tech course was taken place in 2006. The department has also started the PG programme, M.Tech. (by Research) in the year 2007. Currently, it offers the UG, PG and PhD degrees in Computer Engineering. The department grew in terms of the increase in the intake of the UG students from 30 to 120.

There are 10 full time faculty members and among these two faculty members are on Le-in, serving at higher positions at other institutes and also served as faculty members aboard which is an achievement for the department. 90% faculty members are having Doctoral degree. Currently, the department has faculty strength of 3 Professors, 2 Associate Professors, 5 Assistant Professors against total sanctioned strength of 28 faculty members. However, the deficit in the human resources is attempted to be made up by hiring teaching assistants. Many of them serve on the editorial boards of a variety of journals, serve on program committees, publish books, and serve as fellows and chairs of organizations within the ACM and IEEE. The faculty members are participating in different training programmes conducted at other IITs which help in updating self with current state of the art development in the different areas of computer science. The number of short term training programmes is organized under AICTE, QIP, TEQIP scheme for training the students and faculty members of other institutes. The department offers world class environment forlearning and research to around 480 undergraduates, and 78 (40 Masters and 38 Doctoral) graduate students. The department has awarded 39 doctoral degrees till today and 38 other scholars are pursuing their PhD degree.

Department has very focused activities on research, industrial interaction, introduction of innovative courses, quality faculty training, and collaborative ventures with the industry for strengthening the existing UG/PG/PhD programs and alleviating them to be at par with those at the International level. The department has been highly motivated to pursue high quality research. The research areas that are being investigated at the department are Information Security & Privacy in Cloud Computing, Information Security & Privacy Issues in Resource-constrained environments like Wireless Sensor Networks, Privacy Preservation in Data Mining, Optimizing Protocols in Wireless Sensor Networks using Genetic Algorithms, Automatic Summarization of Video, Automatic Text Classification, Approaches for Temporal Data Mining, Ontologies in Software Engineering, Resource Discovery and Load Balancing in Distributed Systems, Recommendation system, Resource optimization and scheduling in IoT environment, Social network analysis etc. In brief, the department humbly boasts of significant reputation of excellence in the areas of Information Security, Cloud Computing, Soft Computing, Computer Vision, Image processing, Natural Language Processing, Mobile Communications, Data Mining, Artificial Intelligence and Internet of Things.

Faculties of the department have successfully executed the number of research projects funded by Space

Applications Centre-Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), Department of Science & Technology (DST), Govt. of India and Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), Govt. of India. Among these projects are: (i) ISRO sponsored project on Design and Implementation of Security Attributes driven link layer architecture for Wireless Sensor Networks under RESPOND, sanctioned in 2009, amount of Rs. 7.43 lakhs for the duration of two years (ii) MeitY sponsored project on A Secure Data Aggregation System and an Intrusion Detection System for Wireless Sensor Networks, sanctioned in 2011, amount of Rs. 48.864 lakhs for the duration of three years (iii) DST sponsored joint research project with main PI from DAIICT, Gandhinagar, on Immersive Navigation for Walk Through Application under Indian Digital Heritage (IDH-Hampi) Phase-II, of amount Rs. 37.60 lakhs from 2011-2016 (iv) MeitY sponsored project on Collaborative Data Processing and Resource Optimization for Post Disaster Management and Surveillance using Internet of Things, sanctioned amount Rs. 65 lakhs from 2016-2019. The department is also part of MeitY sanctioned project on Information Security Education and Awareness (ISEA) from 2007-08 onwards and received the fund of amount Rs. 31.05 laksh and 63.09511 lakhs during the phase I and phase II respectively. The department has also received various grants under modernization and upgradation of various laboratories infrastructure and computing facility. The department has also signed MoU with CDAC under National Supercomputing Mission and setup two super nodes for to facilitate high performance computing.

The department has well-equipped laboratories consisting of the state-of-the-art servers, computers, microprocessor kits, network simulator and emulator kits, RFID system, high-end servers and workstations, Cloud rack, manageable/unmanageable switches and routers. variety of sensor motesand drones with embedded device, used by the students of undergraduate and graduate degree. The dedicated laboratory funded by MHRD under the National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) has been established for the purpose of E-learning through online Web and Video courses in Engineering. The Department has always strived for excellence and receives grants to develop and modernize its laboratories. The department is also benefited from TEQIP project and procured the number of hardware and software tools under this project. The department has total 12 laboratories, among these, four laboratories are completely dedicated to different research areas, namely, Data Science, High Performance Computing, Computer Graphics and Vision, and Network & Information Security. The department is also actively involved in providing consultancy service to government offices, local civic body and private industries in the region.

As per other NITs, top quality students are admitted to the department through the national competitive test JEE and JoSAA process which is centralized admission process for all IITs and NITs. The curriculum is designed keeping in view industrial and research needs, as well as the rapid development in the IT industry. The curriculum is updated at regular interval for induction of new courses from time to time which enables the students to keep abreast of recent technological development. The department offers numerous ways of getting involved in hands-on research through industry sponsored internships, short term training programmes in different research areas and project fellow under on-going research projects to the students which provides an opportunity for generating new ideas and technology innovations and gain a real professional edge. The students are motivated to participate in different competitions and events organized at national level. ACM ICPC and Hackathon are such events. The students also participate and present technical papers at national level symposiums, and achieve laurels. Many of the graduate students have publications in reputed national and international journals/conferences. The department is exploring for more industry interaction and entrepreneurship activities in the department.

(Most Important) Build up your persona (Non Academic part of you):

Once you are eligible, a student with 60 is at par with one having 95%. Your persona will decide who is selected. But better academics will always help in performing the Job better (If at all you are selected!!) Communication/Public Speaking/English Skills: Better English language makes you earn more. Best way of learning English is reading Newspapers & talking in English.

The selection process of Tier 1 IT companies is almost non-technical. 



ANSHUL KOTHARI

Anshul Kothari is a professional swimmer who has represented India in Commonwealth Games 2010, Asian Games 2010, Asian Games 2014 and Asian Games 2018. He has also won 21 medals for India at international competitions. Anshul

is one of the few athletes over the world to have played sport at the elite level as well as having dual degrees from prestigious institutes such as the Indian School of Business, Hyderabad (ISB) and SardarVallabhbhai National Institute of Technology, Surat (SVNIT).

At the age of 4, he was diagnosed with chronic flat foot condition. Many doctors said he would never be able to walk straight again and thus advised his parents for surgery but his parents took a non-conventional route and put him into sports and physical activities.

In 2010, he was the first swimmer from Gujarat in the history of the state to play both Commonwealth Games and Asian Games. The Government of Gujarat has felicitated Anshul with Sardar Patel Award in 2006 and Junior Eklavya award in 2014, for his achievements and contribution to the sport of swimming.

Anshul completed his graduation in Computer Engineering (B.Tech) from SVNIT in 2012. During his years at SVNIT, Anshul continued his sport simultaneously making several appearances on the Indian Team.

In 2016, Anshul missed qualification for Olympics by a mere 0.15 seconds.

Anshul has also completed an MBA from the prestigious Indian School of Business, Hyderabad in 2018. At ISB, he continued to swim along with academics winning 5 international medals in the process. On graduation he was awarded the "Torchbearer Award" for exceptional service, commitment and Leadership.

In late 2018, Anshul qualified for the Asian Games for 3rd consecutive time where he finished 8th in the finals of 4x100m Freestyle Relay, creating a new national record with his teammates.

Anshul is currently chasing his dream of qualifying for the Olympics 2020.

Fostering Innovators (Makers) in Rural and Tribal India

UniqYOU International School, Idar an initiative by The Good Human Being Foundation, Gandhinagar is driven by the PURA (Provision of Urban- amenities in Rural Area) thought of Former President and Visionary Dr APJ Abdul Kalaam for the India Vision 2020. We are fortunate to be instrumental in inculcating maker spirit in the children from rural and tribal areas of North Gujarat, with the help of competent collaborators including Prof Rajesh Nair of MIT, USA.

To take our efforts to the next level, for the scalable and sustainable rural development, we came up with one big intervention in the form of Rural Premier League - Robotics Season 1. This was a unique undertaking to build village-based community driven ecosystem to build maker-spirit for the rural and tribal students at the very young age. We travelled across over 80+ villages, and formed 60 teams, giving them kits worth 3K. The response we got was something we could scarcely even dream of. Kids down here have such sharp and innovative minds that can definitely change the world.

Each village was given a kit of basic components of electronics, such as motors, chassis, wires, wheels, etc. They were given problem statements for different tasks, like manoeuvring their robot through an obstacle track, fighting each other's robot in a ring (RoboKushti), etc. Their design skills were also tested. Each village's team consisted of 5 children, under 15 years of age, which were guided by a youth, under 25 years of age, from the same village. 360 student were directly involved and over 3000 students were indirectly benefited from RPL for the Robotics. Total we were able to reach to over 5000 students, parents, teachers etc.

It's organized parallel to the Indian Premier League (IPL) for cricket, which is very popular across India. RPL give a positive learning opportunity during summer vacation for students to connect and compete with their age group peers from within and around their villages. Since they tend to work hard to keep their village team on a winning track, the ecosystem is formed in the village for STEM learnings and Innovations. This intervention helps all people from the village viz. Sarpanch, other leading people, technician, artisans, and teachers to take this momentum forward for the students and youth of the village to the next level. Indeed there are lot of students, in the remote part of rural and tribal area, who are highly talented, but for the want of directions, opportunity and resources, they often lack initiative, confidence and ecosystem to explore and challenge their talents. This lead to them to pass their vacation in not so productive use by watching TV, playing around online games, mobile. This obstructs their thinking capacity and innovative hands-on exploration. Our work and engagement for over 7 years with the rural and tribal area of North Gujarat led us believe in them, hence we have taken up this challenge of exploring self-directed and peer to peer learning to bring them closer to technology and innovation. We believe that this intervention of RPL 2019 will change some of the students forever on the path of thinking, curiosity and self-exploration in their chosen field. On the Championships final day, students were inspired by acknowledging them that their level of participation was not less than degree engineering students. This remarks were given by Vice Chancellor of Gujarat Technological University (GTU) Dr Navin Sheth. GTU is the technical university which covers all degree, diploma engineering colleges, MBA, MCA and Pharmacy colleges of Gujarat. This year, I was helped by my son, Sat and his friends, students of current batch of SVNIT. Next year, we are planning to come up with season 2, covering more than 180+ villages. The tentative theme for this coming season is Augmented Reality and Virtual Reality. Looking forward for more participation from the Alumni, Institute and Students from SVNIT.

Was born in 1953and completed schooling from Sainik School, Korukonda (AP) Joined five-year Integrated Civil Engineering course at National Institute of Technology, Surat in July 1970. Represented the South Gujarat University team in football and captained its hockey team. Was the college athletic champion for four consecutive years. Graduated in July 1975 and was selected to the Indian Army.

Was Commissioned in June 1976 from the Indian Military Academy in to the Corps of Engineers. A Graduate of Defence Services Staff College and Army War College. Held important Command, Staff and Instructional appointments in the army including operational service in Kashmir. Commanded an Assault Engineer Regiment of the in 1996. Was awarded the Chief of Army Staff Commendation. Attained speciality in Combat Engineering, Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear (CBRN) Defence and Disaster Management and Counter Explosive Devices Operations. As the Joint Director for CBRN Defence, the Ministry of Defence (Army), was responsible for evolving, planning and executing CBRN Defence measures including Disaster Management for the Indian Armed Forces. Took voluntary retirement from the army.

Was a member of the International Civil Service from Jan 1997 to Dec 2004, while working as the Chief Chemical Weapons Inspector with the Organisation for Prohibition of Chemical Weapons (OPCW), The Hague, The Netherlands. Had undergone Advance Chemical Weapons and Disarmament training in France, Germany, Italy, The Netherlands, Russian Federation, the UK and the USA. Led teams of international professionals on a large number of verification missions to various member countries, to verify the inventory of Chemical Weapons (CW) and monitor their destruction. Received recognition for my contribution towards Chemical Disarmament and Non-proliferation when OPCW was awarded Nobel Peace Prize for 2013.

A qualified CBRN and C-IED Professional presently Chief Consultant with 'CBRNe Secure India' a 'Knowledge Centre' to bring awareness in the general public, government and security entities on the threats arising from the use of CBRNe material and their disastrous consequences. Has been speaking extensively in various international & domestic fora on CBRN and C-IED Issues. Contributes articles to many CBRN and C IED related journals worldwide. Was the visiting faculty for the University of Rome for CBRNe Masters Programme.



From Science to Services

It was in 2007 I had completed my 12th ISC board exams with an average score. All I looked for, is to get an admission in an engineering college. Although being from Surat, little did I fancy that I would get myself enrolled in the then newly started Five Years Integrated Masters in Science in SVNIT. I was the first one to register in the institute's first M.Sc. program in Physics, my roll no. being I07PH001.

Being a newly formed department, we struggled initially to make our presence felt, be it in partaking in various activities or in placements or such already existing established ventures. But keeping aside all shortcomings, we ensured we were counted at par with other branches. In fact, the present Society for Cultivation of Sciences and Humanities (SCOSH), an exclusive Science Society of the institute was formed with the efforts of this batch, Dr. Akashrup Banerjee being the founder and I was the first Secretary of the society.

Our batch, in the third year had bagged four all-expenses paid internships to prestigious institutes in Germany, France and Switzerland, an achievement which spoke volumes about our determination to pursue in research fields, a trend which is still continuing in large numbers. I also had an opportunity to do a similar paid internship in University of Duisburg, Germany after my third year. I had plans of continuing in research after my M.Sc. as I had a fair exposure in Optics in a field of Nonlinear Optics. In my final year dissertation, I published a research paper in Physics Review Letters (PRL), a reputed journal in Physics, while working under Dr.K.P. Singh, IISER, Mohali.

Meanwhile, after I passed out in 2012 with an 8.3 CGPA, I had a brief leisure time at home and was waiting for PhD calls from various institutes in India and abroad. During this time, I came across a Fast-Track interview for recruitment to Indian Air Force as Officers and I thought to give it a try, as it used to be a dream job in my school days. I cleared this interview of five days (SSB) by the abundant grace of God and got selected (the only one from 70 who appeared in the interview!!). What immediately followed was an invitation to Max Planck Institute for Optics, Germany for a PhD interview, to which I attended as it was again a free trip, but by this time I had made up my mind for defence services only.

After joining the strenuous training at Air Force Academy Hyderabad for an year, I got commissioned by the President of India as a Flying Officer on 14th December 2013 and I was posted to Kashmir on my first posting. Primarily, I am a meteorological officer and my job is to forecast weather for military flying. However, all armed forces officers are trained to do all jobs varying from management, administration, security, training and what not.

Currently, I am posted to Kutch in Gujarat and would like to be a helping hand to all our Alumni of SVNIT, in whatever capacity I can. Setting a precedent, five others followed me to join Indian Air Force and they are all doing well in different parts of the country.
