#### About the Department

Computer Engineering Department had been setup with an intake of 30 students in the year 1988 under the Electronics Engineering Department of Sardar Vallabhbhai Regional College of Engineering and Technology (SVRCET) offering the bachelor of engineering in Computer Engineering. SVRCET became the institute of national importance and designated as National Institute of Technology in the year 2002. The Computer Engineering Department has its own individual department identity in the year 2002 and offering the degree bachelor of technology in Computer Engineering. The department has started offering PhD degree from the year 2005. Post-graduation degree Master of Technology in Computer Engineering in 2006. The Master of Technology by Research M.Tech. (R) has been started in year 2007 to facilitate the higher education to working technical person in the industry and different organization. The B.Tech. intake strength is 135 as on today. The B.Tech. Computer Engineering degree name has been changed to B.Tech. in Computer Science and Engineering onwards 2019-20. The M.Tech. programme name is also changed to M.Tech. in Computer Science and Engineering from the next academic year 2021-22. The department has various specialization like information security, data mining, social network analysis, cloud computing, privacy preserving, cyber security, image processing, computer vision, software engineering. The department has executed several research projects sponsored by different agencies Department of Science and Technology, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology, Indian Space Research Organization and Department of Science and Technology of Gujarat Government (GUJCOST). The department has also obtained the grant under Information Security Education and Awareness (ISEA) programme. The department is also beneficiary of TEQIP grant from phase I, II and III. The alumni of the department are now serving in various industries and few of them are entrepreneurs. The department is also planning to start the different specialization post graduate programmes in the area of Artificial Intelligence, Data Science and Information Security as a part of perspective development plan of the institute. The department has state of art computing desktop PCs, blade servers and super nodes for High performance computing. The department has availed two super nodes from C-DAC under the National Supercomputing Mission. The department has server wireless network simulator software and sensor motes. Different wireless sensor kits are also available in the department including aerial drones. Currently 40 number of students are pursing PhD degree. The department faculty members are very much involved with different academic activities and organized various short term training programmes for faculty members and students from other institutes. The department has also signed MoU with different industries.
